

## Bling Bling Lampwork Charm Bracelet by Teresa Jones

We will make a charm bracelet with mostly glass and sterling silver. This is a beginner class. I will be teaching basic wire wrapping and color design with tips on using lampwork glass beads in your jewelry designs.

Techniques to be covered: wire wrapping, color balance, lampwork bead tips

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• 35 SS bead caps</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• 15 Swarovski Crystals (7mm or smaller)</li> </ul>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• 30 SS jump rings (20 gauge)</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• 20 pearls or other coordinating beads</li> </ul>
